Information Items for Parents

Parking at Drop-Off & Pick-Up

Parents are asked to use the marked area of the sidewalk as a loading/unloading zone only. We ask that parents do not park in this area for more than the necessary amount of time to upload or load children (5 minutes) to ensure that everyone has the opportunity to pull in and drop off or pick up their children within a reasonable distance from their entrances. Bylaw officers do monitor this area and have given tickets for parking over the allotted loading/unloading time.

Sick at School
