### Handicapped Parking/Loading/Unloading Zone

We have been working with the town to solve some of our parking issues on 53rd ave. A new Handicapped Parking zone will be in effect just west of our crosswalk. Please watch for the blue curb and signage. This zone will need to be kept clear for vehicles with a handicapped placard. In addition, the yellow curb indicates a loading/unloading zone which means that vehicles parked in this area must be actively loading or unloading students. Parking for longer periods of time is not permitted. Peace Officers will be monitoring the area.

### Cellphones

We are seeing more and more of our students with cellphones. Students often use them to text parents after school and to ensure a ride is on the way. This is a great way to ensure that everyone is where they need to be. We do, however, ask that students not use them during the school day.
